Our ministry welcomes and celebrates a baby's birth with our families.



Baptism is the way we welcome babies into Christ's family. It happens four or five times annually on the Sunday after Easter, All Saints, Epiphany, Pentecost, and Transfiguration Sunday.



Communion for children can be taken at any age, but instruction is given in a parent/child class for children who are four or five years old. As a part of this experience, families discover the what, why, and how we do communion.
