PRESCHOOL CLASS - meets in the Nursery

This class is geared toward our Pre-K group and uses a combination of Godly Play, Bible story time, and related crafts to teach children about the love of Jesus. Class is led by the nursery manager.

WHAT'S IN THE BIBLE? – meets in the Children's Chapel This class for grades K-3 teaches children about God, the Bible, and faith through lectionary-based lessons, songs, and related crafts. Class is team-taught by a talented group of leaders who love children and love Jesus.

4/5/6 CLASS – meets in the Family Life Center

The transition to middle school and youth group can be a big jump! This small group style class for 4th, 5th, and 6th graders gives them a space that bridges that gap. Class is taught by a wonderful team of leaders who love having fun and facilitating meaningful discussions about God and living a life of faith.

Our Saviour's Grief Group uses *Beyond the Broken Heart*, an eight-week Christ-centered grief ministry for those who have lost a loved one. The study aims to explain the spiritual and practical issues of grief and suggests specific coping strategies. Within the sanctity and community of this group, there is opportunity to share with others and receive the spiritual and emotional encouragement that leads to a life of renewed hope and joy.

This program is presented periodically. Participants are not required to share, but are provided with a safe environment in which to express as little or as much as is needed.


